EVEN DURING THE WARMEST MONTHS, TEAMS CONTINUETHEIR WORK ON SNOW. END OF JULY MARKS A UNIQUE MIGRATION: ALMOST EVERY NATION SENDS ITS ATHLETES TO INDOOR SKI HALLS IN BELGIUM AND THE NETHERLANDS. THESE CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENTS ARE PERFECT FOR TESTING NEW SKIS, FINE-TUNING GEAR, AND MAINTAINING THE ALLIMPORTANT FEEL FOR SNOW. IN PARALLEL, MANY ATHLETES HEAD TO EUROPE'S HIGH-ALTITUDE GLACIERS (ZERMATT, SAAS-FEE, AND THE STELVIO) WHERE REAL-SNOW CONDITIONS OFFER ANOTHER ESSENTIAL LAYER OF PREPARATION.

AFTER THAT, THE TEAMS SPREAD ACROSS THE GLOBE. MANY DOWNHILLERS HEAD TO SOUTH AMERICA (ARGENTINA AND CHILE) FOR LONGER, FASTER SLOPES SUITED TO SPEED TRAINING. MEANWHILE, TECHNICAL SKIERS OFTEN TRAVEL TO NEW ZEALAND. THE SHORTER BUT STEEPER TERRAIN THERE MIRRORS THE TIGHT TURNS AND HIGH-PRECISION DEMANDS OF SLALOM AND GIANT SLALOM DISCIPLINES.

### Luca Aerni



A turning point for ski racing. On June 13, the International Ski & Snowboard Federation (FIS) introduced major reforms aimed at building a safer, more professional, and more sustainable sport. These include a +20% increase in World Cup prize money, new safety standards (like the ban on rigid shin guards), mandatory CO<sub>2</sub> measurement tools for event organizers, and updated equipment regulations. The 2025/26 calendar has also been finalized.


